"No thanks." they were told.

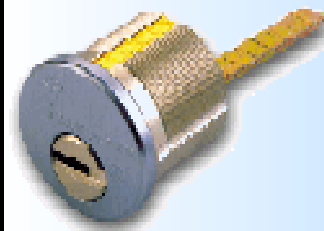
